

“144-hour Convenient Visa to Guangdong Province” Application Procedures

Step

1

- Foreign visitors who wish to apply for a 144-hour Convenient Visa must be the ordinary passport holders of nations with diplomatic relations with China. They are required to join guided tours (a minimum of 2 persons) organised by a registered Hong Kong travel agent to Guangdong cities[#] after arriving Hong Kong.

[#] Guangdong cities include Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Zhuhai, Foshan, Dongguan, Zhongshan, Jiangmen, Zhaoqing, Huizhou and Shantou.

Step

2

- Hong Kong travel agent to submit the list of names of all tour group members to a registered Guangdong travel agent for the 144-hour Convenient Visa application.

Step

3

- Guangdong travel agent to submit the application documents to the relevant ports of entry and exit in Guangdong province to apply for the 144-hour Convenient Visa.
- Processing time of application is about one working day (cut-off time is 16:00 every day).

Step

4

- Successful tour group applicants are able to stay at Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Zhuhai, Foshan, Dongguan, Zhongshan, Jiangmen, Zhaoqing, Huizhou and Shantou^{##} for a maximum of 144 hours.

^{##} Tours to Shantou are restricted to enter and exit via Shantou port only, and their activities must be conducted within the Shantou area.
